



The 42nd Torino Film Festival begins

November 22 – 30, 2024

Friday, November 22, starting at 5:30 p.m., the red carpet rolled out in Piazza Castello will make Turin feel like it's in Hollywood. "The **Teatro Regio** is the ideal setting to inaugurate the **Torino** *Film Festival*," says Enzo Ghigo, president of the National Cinema Museum. "The grand building designed by Mollino is a gem that lends itself well as the backdrop for the stars who will attend the inaugural evening, an important moment for both the museum and the festival. The collaboration between our two organizations is long-standing and we are very pleased to see it further reinforced on this important and prestigious occasion, at a moment when Turin is the focus of international attention thanks to the events it hosts and the stars we have in town."

Expectations are growing for a festival (November 22 – 30, 2024) that promises to be of international scope. Comments Giulio Base, artistic director of the Torino Film Festival, "Yesterday, we announced the complete program of the 42nd TFF. A program that fills me with pride. For the plurality of the topics treated; for the quality of the selected movies (120 selected out of the 6,000 proposed); for the prestige of the guests who will attend; and, last but not least, for the number of competing female directors, who outnumber the male directors. And it will be a pleasure to have Sarah Jessica Parker, Claudia Gerini, Giuseppe Battiston, Marco Leonardi, Massimo Ghini, Giorgio Tirabassi, Vera Gemma, Charlie McDowell, Fausto Brizzi, Cesare Bocci, and many others in the audience. Lastly, Ron Howard will personally present the international premiere of his most recent movie, Eden, a drama thriller with a star-studded cast."





Mathieu Jouvin, superintendent of the **Teatro Regio**, concludes: "The pulsing heart of Turin's cultural life, the **Teatro Regio is proud to host the inauguration** of the 42nd Torino Film Festival, which opens with the international premiere screening of Eden, the new film by Ron Howard, and which marks the debut of Giulio Base as artistic director. This collaboration between the Teatro Regio and the National Cinema Museum - Torino Film Festival reflects a **profound synergy**: like the Festival, our Theatre, too, is a laboratory of innovation that pays careful attention to the new generations.
